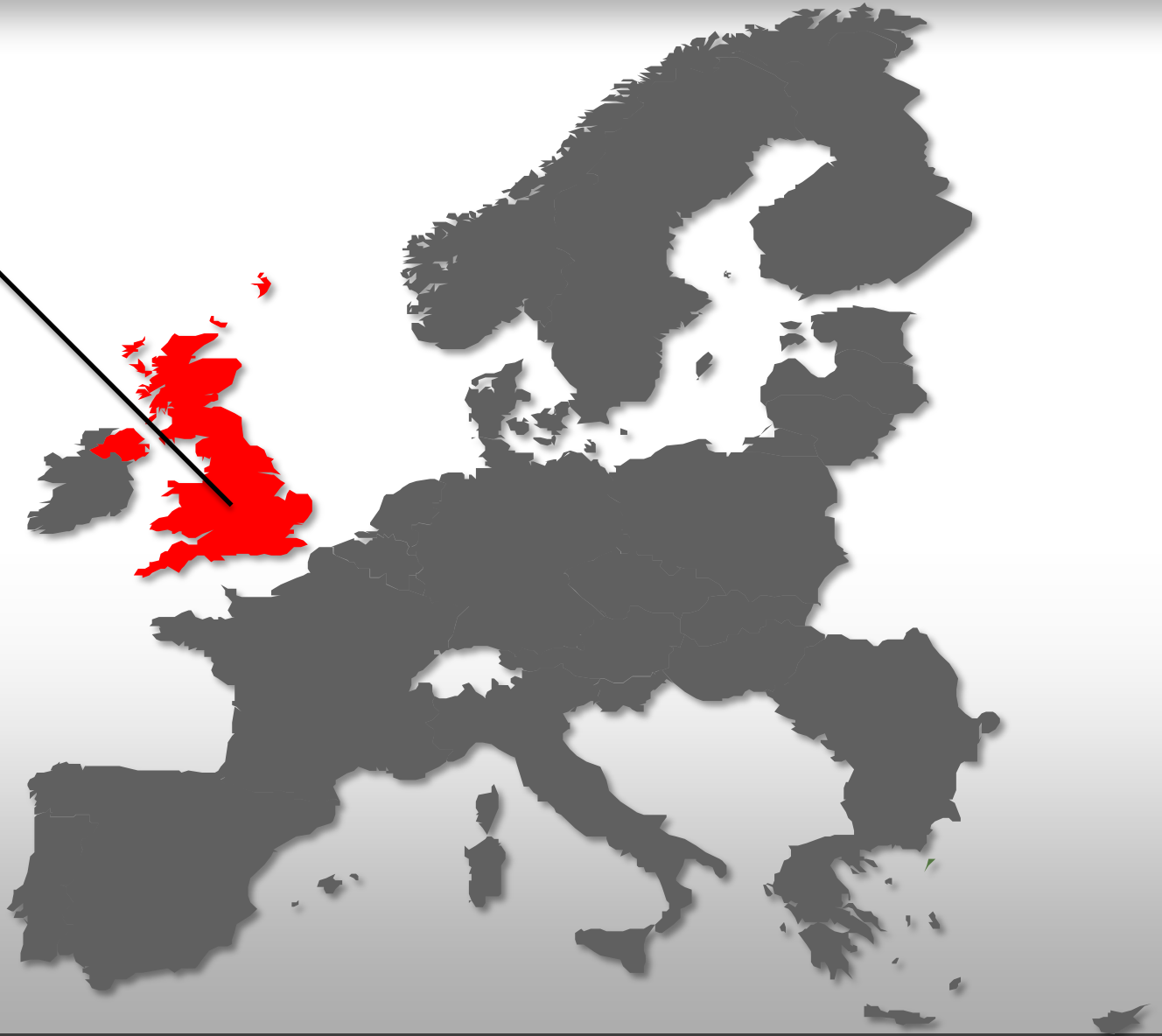

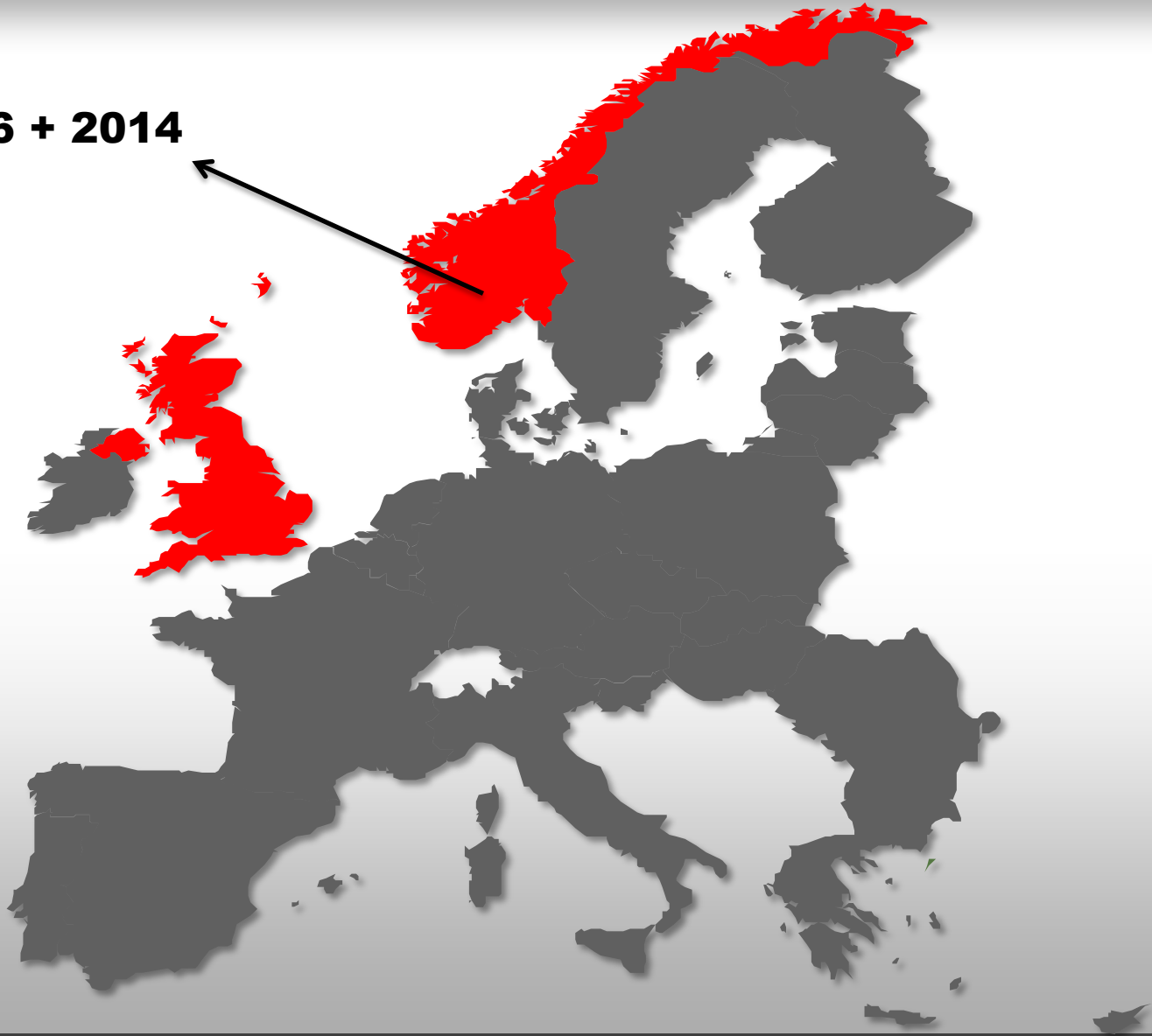

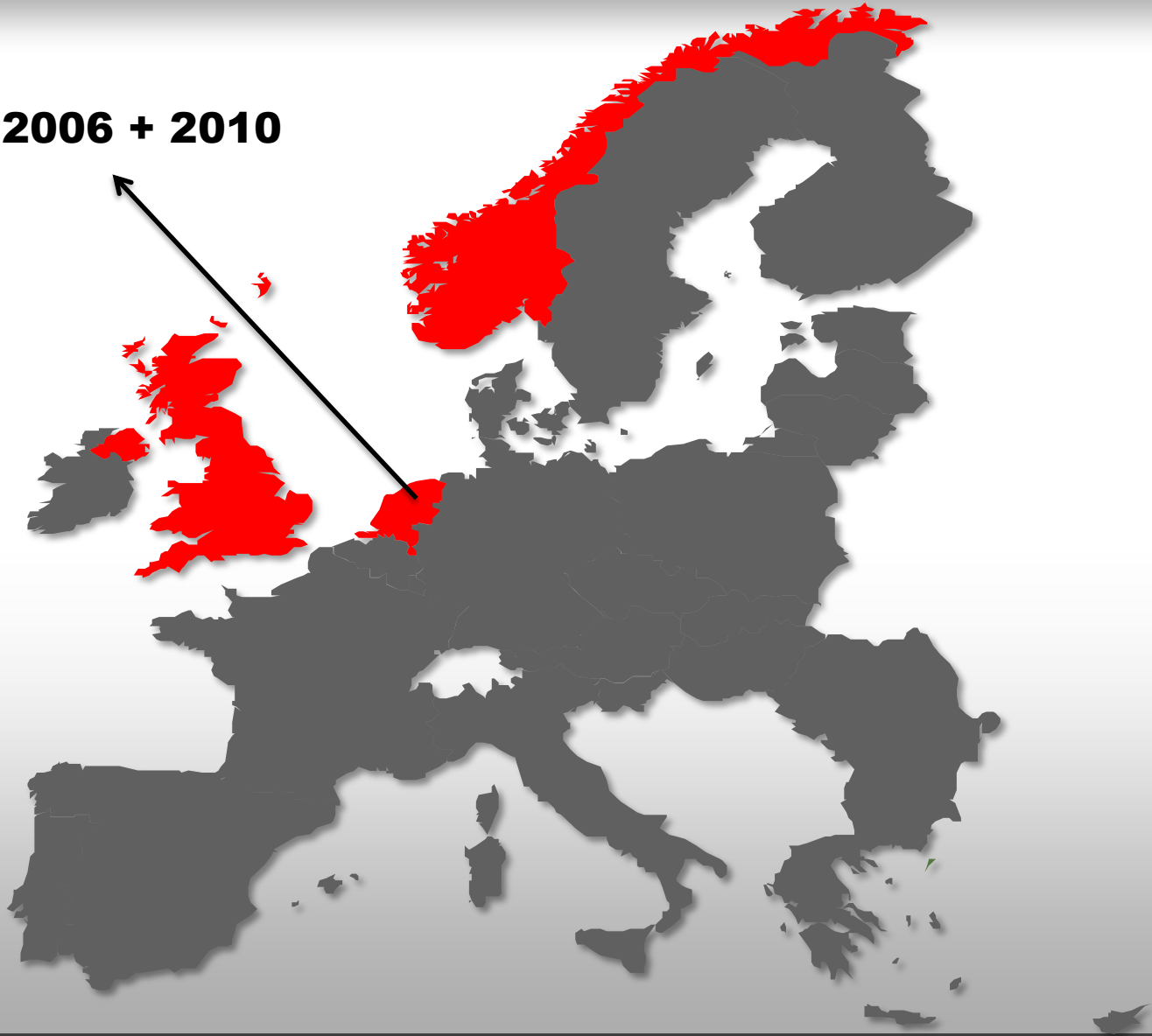

Norway – 2006 + 2014



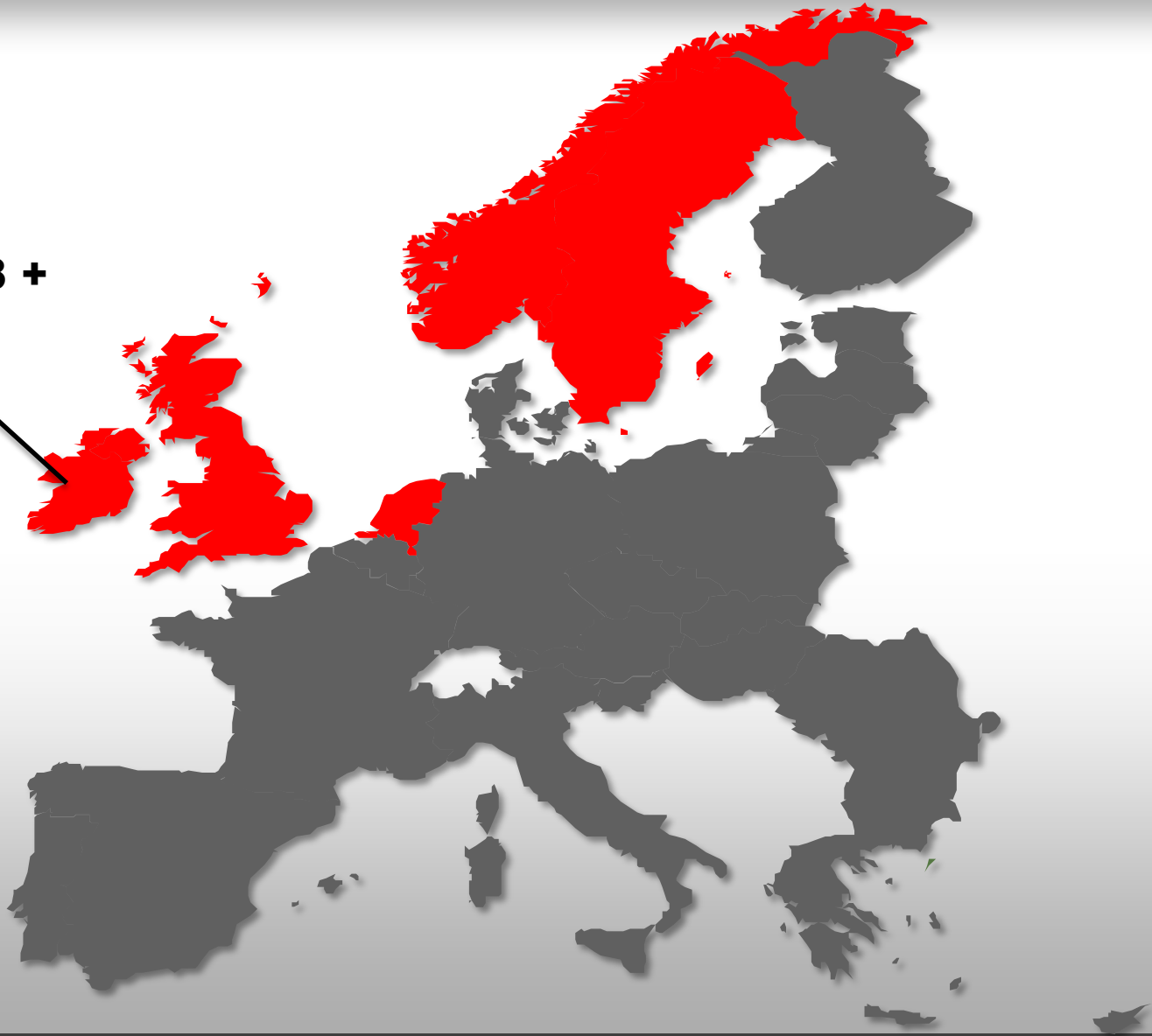

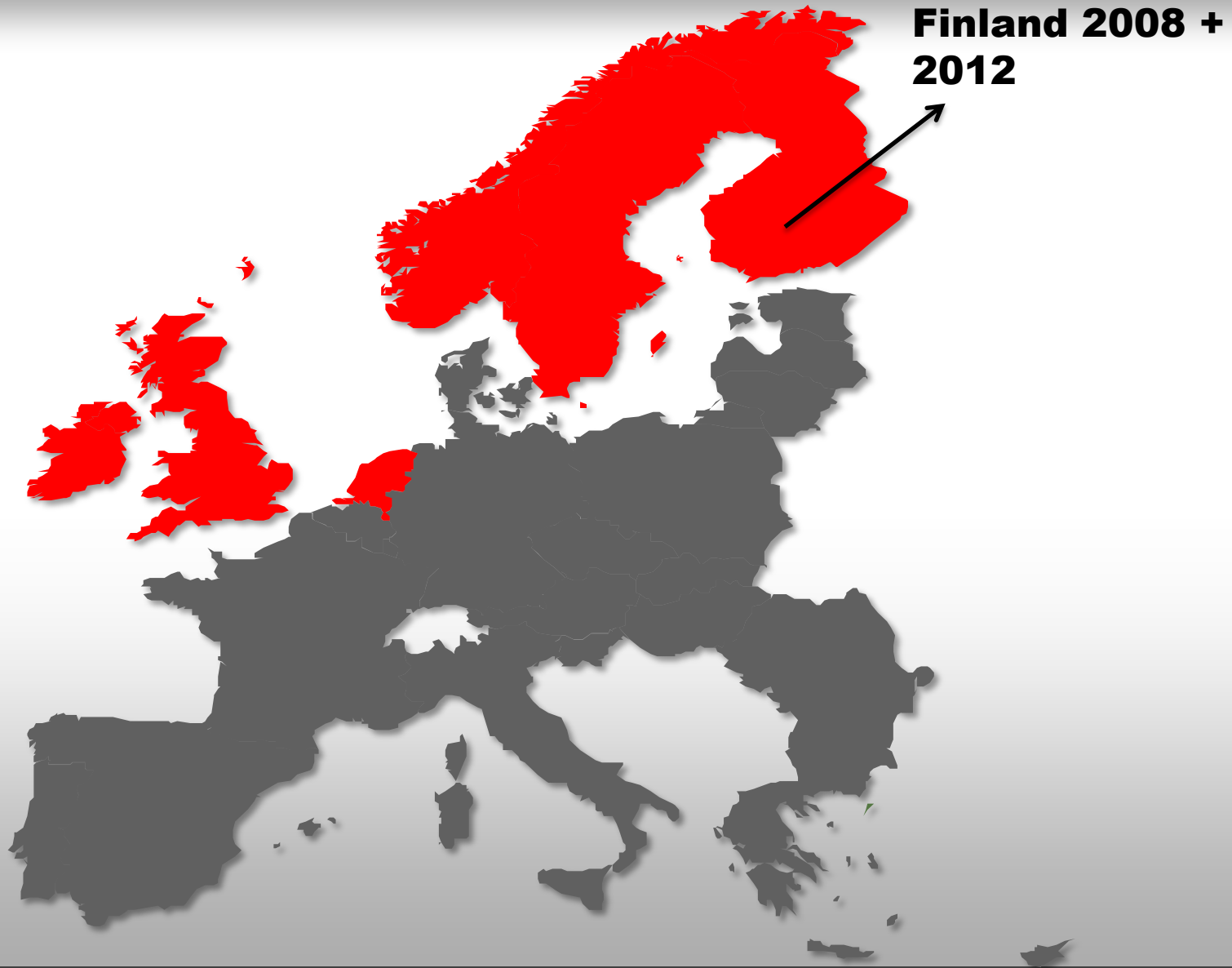

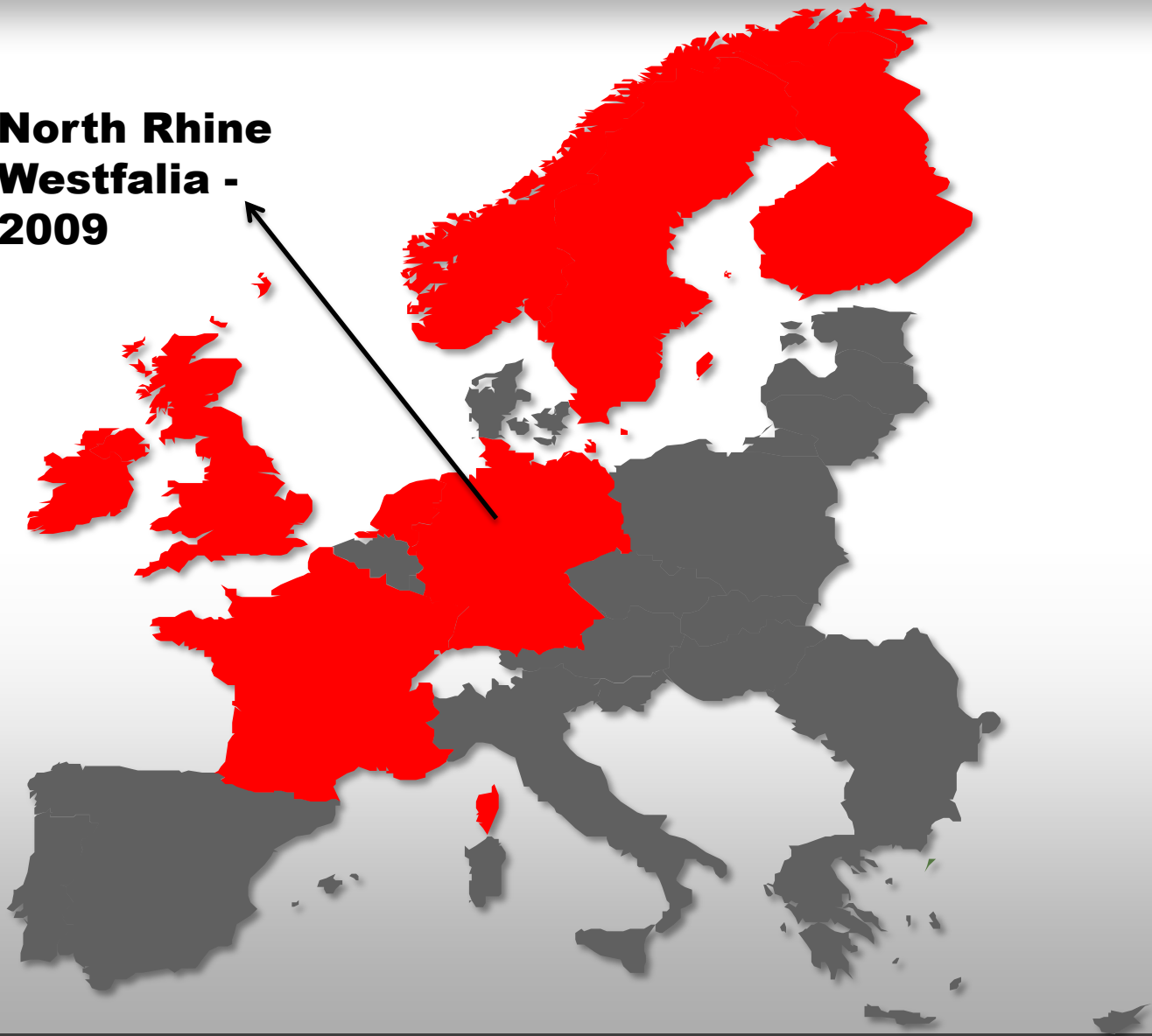

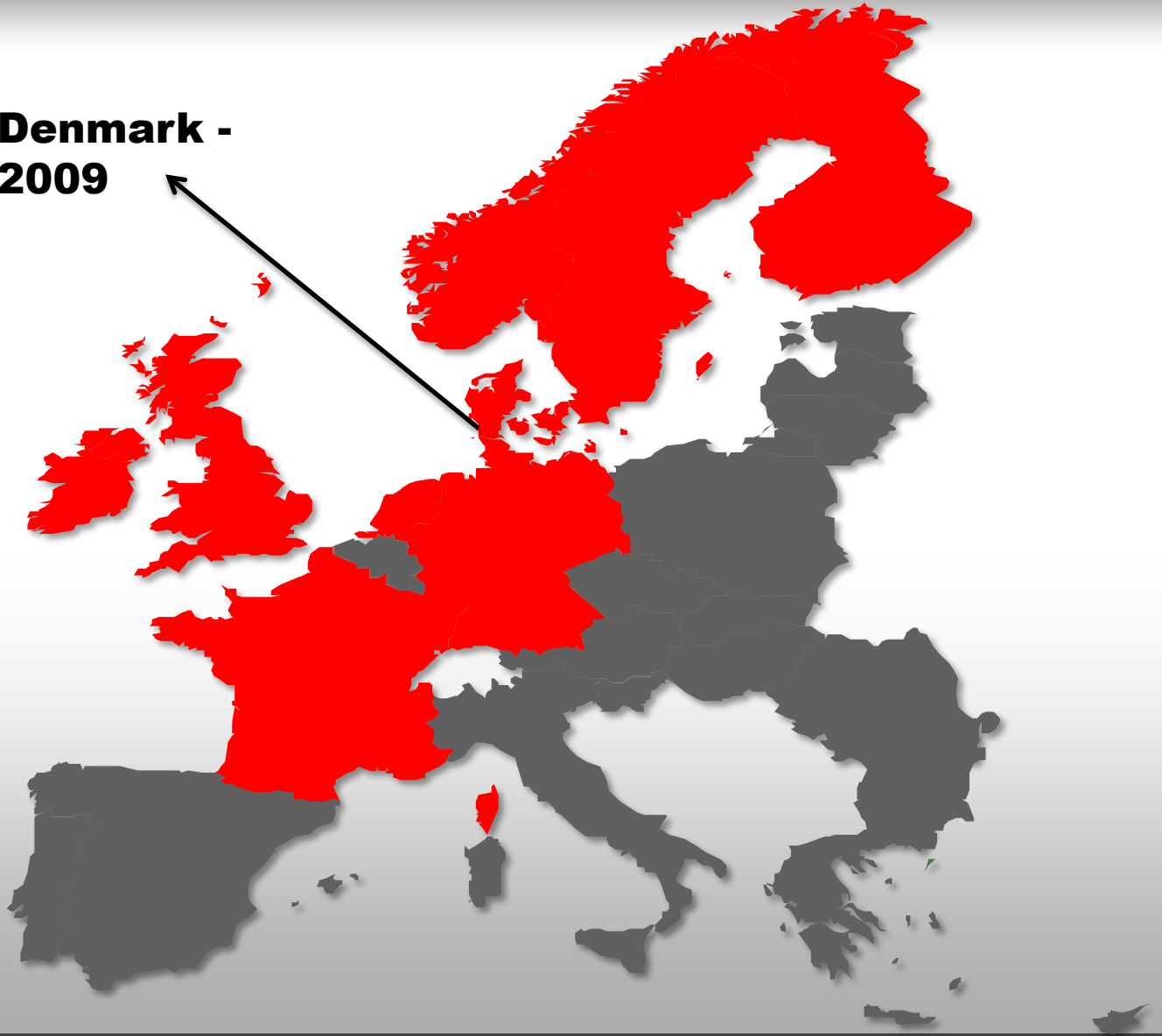

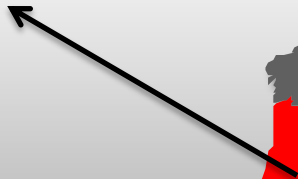

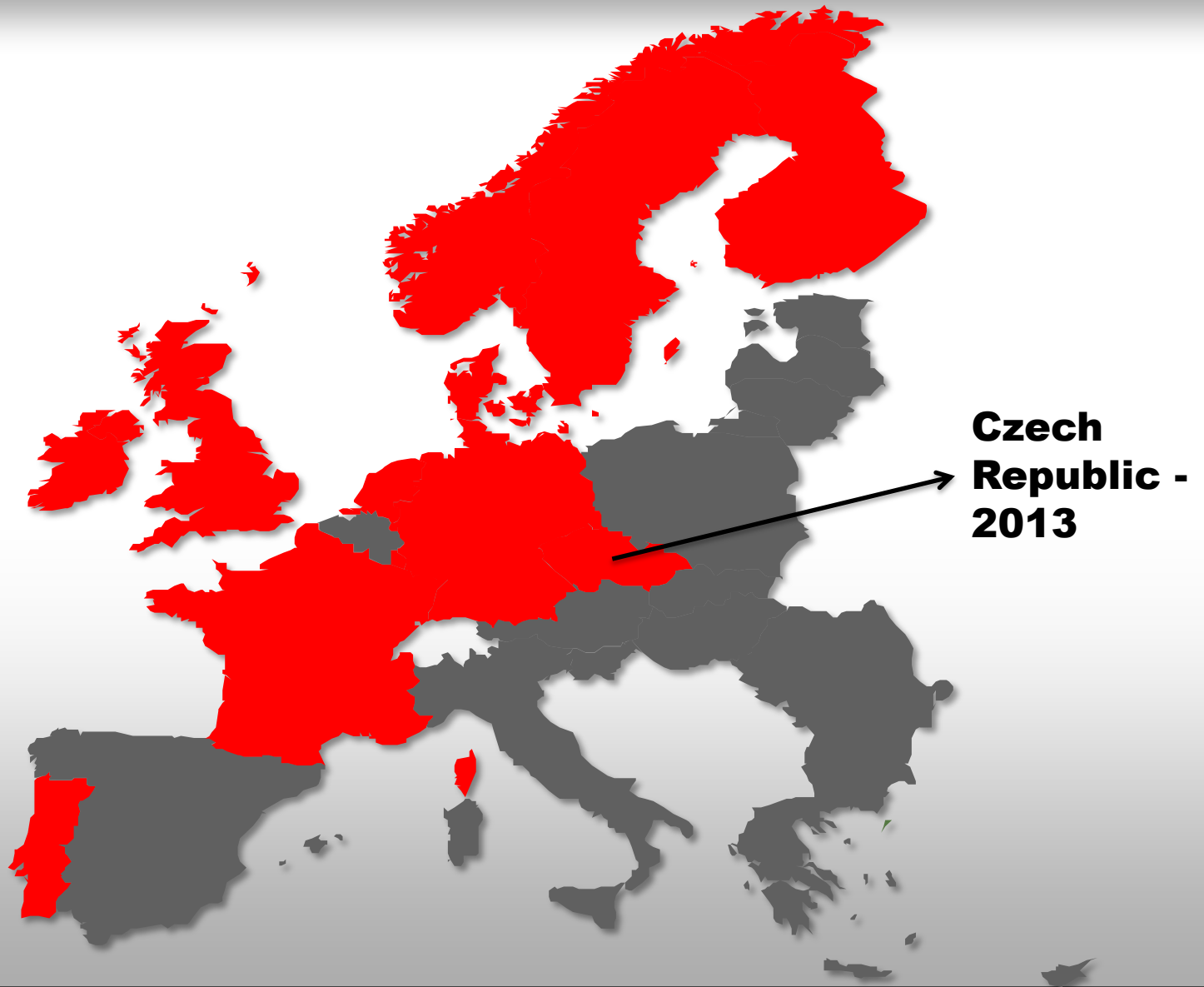

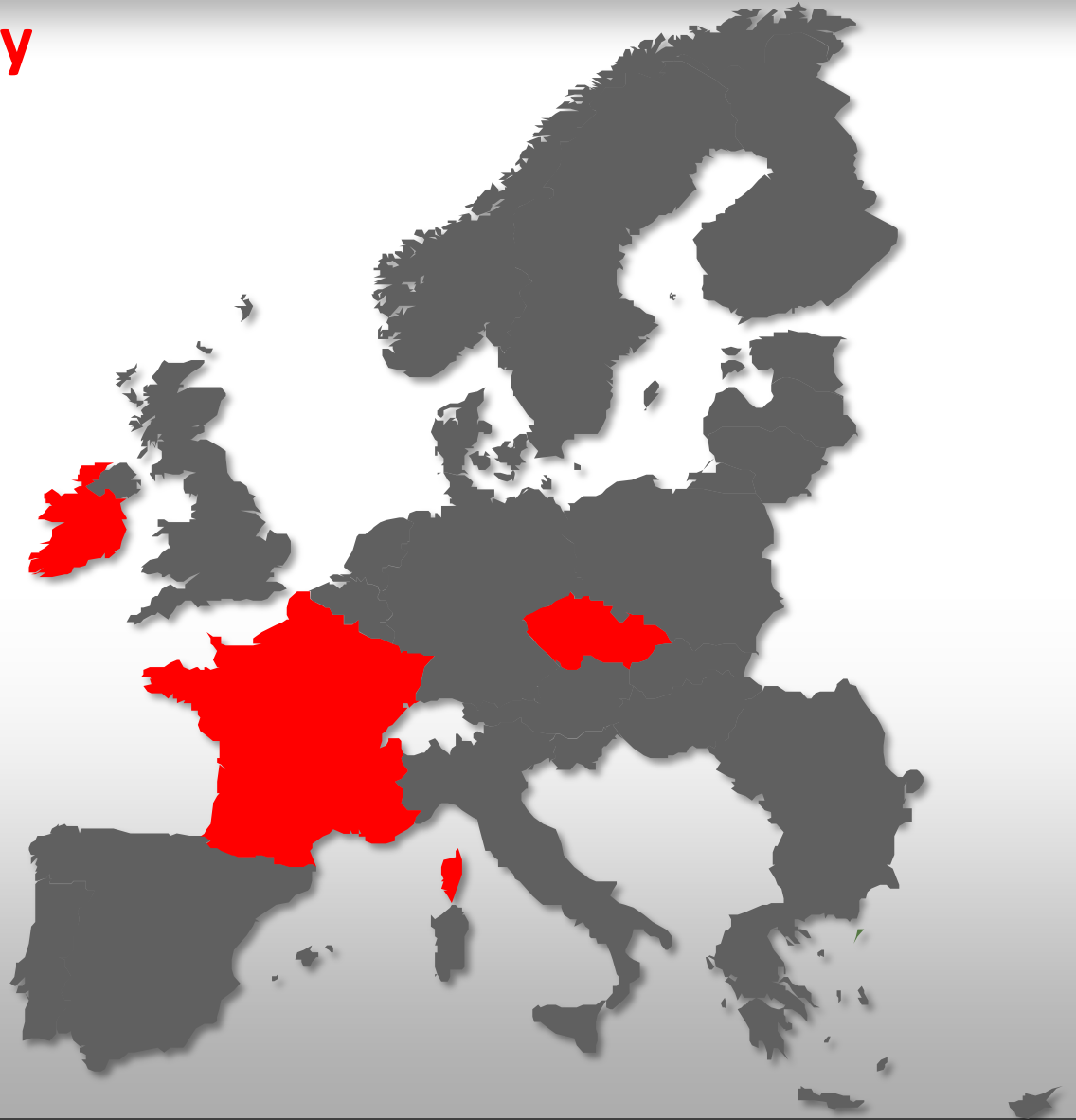
